MICA H continued its legacy of success in 2009. After two years of concentrated effort, the MORE Ordinance (Milwaukee Opportunities for Restoring Employment) was passed by the Milwaukee Common Council. The ground-breaking measure requires developers to hire more underemployed city residents with prevailing wage payments. We have had successes in securing alcohol and drug treatment options for low income people; standing with our immigrant brothers and sisters in their struggle for immigration reform; and obtaining in-state tuition rates for children of undocumented workers who enter the Wisconsin state university system.

In spite of the recession/depression, MICA H is experiencing an exciting time of renewal, as we reflect on more than 20 years of faithfulness in the struggle for justice. I invite you to stay with us on the path for justice and support our work.
